# Brinker Information Systems saves while improving service using Egnyte

Brinker Information Systems is a 22-year-old healthcare service organization based in Minnesota. They help local clinics and hospitals by transcribing medical reports. A doctor will read an x-ray, report, or CT scan and dictate the results. The dictations are then sent to Brinker where they type them up and send them to the facilities and patients that need them.

#### **Opportunity: Increase efficiency**

For years Brinker had been using their own file servers that were housed in a nearby storage facility. After dictating reports, doctors would VPN into the server to deliver the files. The transcriptionists would access those files, type up the reports, and send them to the hospitals. VPN took time and owning equipment was costly and unreliable.
